2. Database Replication & Redis Cache

Deploy read/write database replication splits, separating query loads. Implement Redis object caching to minimize database hits for static settings query tasks.

3. Edge Caching & CDN optimizations

Cache entire HTML page payloads at edge CDN nodes (e.g. Cloudflare Enterprise Cache). This bypasses the origin server for all cache hits, lowering TTFB global metrics.
